

Best Kept Schools Competition 2010

Rules of Entry

1. The Competition is open to all primary and secondary schools in the Ennis Town Council area.
2. All entries for the 2010 Competition must be made on the application form provided.
3. All Schools in the Ennis Area will be invited to participate in the Competition and will be adjudicated based on the following :
 - ◆ Overall Developmental Approach, including involvement in the Green Schools Competition
 - ◆ Litter Control/Litter Awareness Projects
 - ◆ Recycling projects
 - ◆ Wildlife and General Environmental projects
 - ◆ Appearance and Presentation of School Buildings and Yard
4. Your school is required to undertake a recycling or environmental project that can be viewed by the members of the adjudication committee when they visit the schools. The project might consist of, as an example, a landscape, a human being or any object etc. made entirely out of recyclable materials. The nature of the project will be at the discretion of each participating school, whilst ensuring a good degree of creativity and imagination.
5. Completed application forms, must be submitted to Ennis Town Council by **30th April 2010.**
6. The adjudication should take place on or before **31st May 2010.** The team will meet the teachers and pupils to discuss projects and any other work completed.
7. Awards for the Competition will comprise the presentation of Plaques and cheques to the participating schools. The award ceremony and prize presentation will take place before **the end June 2010.** Photos of each school and each project may be displayed and it is hoped to present a slide-show highlighting the work of each of the participating schools.
